- You may choose family members or friends to proclaim the readings, read the petitions, bring up the gifts, and/or be Eucharistic Ministers (if they are commissioned Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Eucharist). Epiphany can provide community members for these ministries, as well.
- You may bring artwork and/or a poem or quotation for the cover of the participation sheet to the office.
