Update on Pastor's Residence

- Committee work complete. Report will be presented to PPC at the July 25th meeting.

2019-2020 Parish Budget

- PPC unanimously approved balanced 2019-2020 budget as it was presented to PPC during May meeting, no changes requested.

New Long Range Plan

- The new Long Range Plan (LRP) will be the focus of the PPC retreat. Retreat will be August 16-18 at Nazareth
- There will be a bulletin insert to request community involvement in the new LRP
- The LRP planning committee will be holding a book study on "Great Catholic Parishes" which will be used as a guideline for the crafting of the new LRP
- There will be a parish-wide survey released in July and will ask for a response from every parishioner age 12 and up (not one per household like the previous survey)
- The LRP committee is reaching out to other peer parishes in the country to get input on their LRP best practices

- Fr. Tony and Fr. Randy are transitioning well with the St. Martin de Porres assignment.
