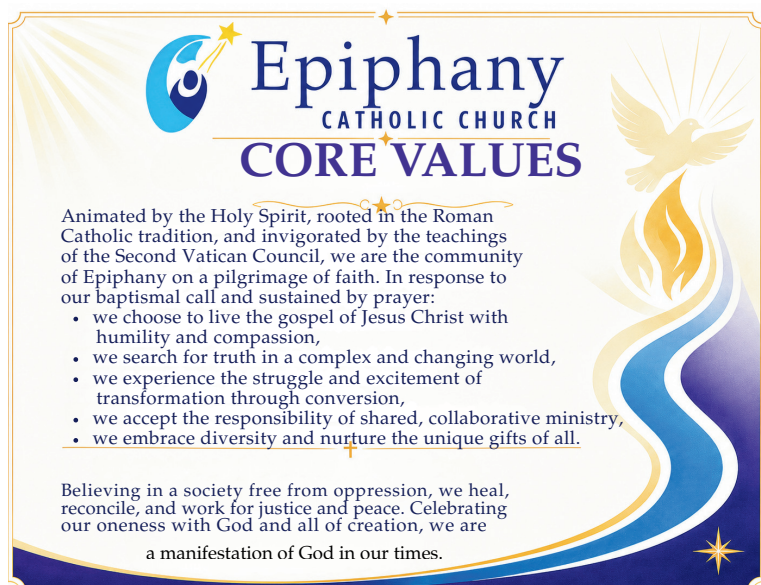

A Note from Fr. Toan

A change in how we announce Mass Intentions during the liturgy

It is our custom to honor requests for a special intention for Mass when someone offers a stipend. We schedule the Mass and report these intentions in our weekly bulletin. We have included the name of that deceased person in our general intercessions (petitions) along with the names of those recently deceased parishioners or their family members. Up to now, these names have been read in the same petition. We will continue to remember those who have recently died in our usual petition. However, in order to help us know the specific intention for whom a Mass is being offered, we will start to pray specifically for a deceased loved one for whom a Mass was requested by mentioning that loved one's name in the Eucharistic Prayer, rather than in the General Intercessions. Each Eucharistic Prayer has a place where we will recall a person by name. So, if you have requested a Mass intention, you will soon hear your loved one's name mentioned at that part of the liturgy. This will be said by the priest presiding that day.

A Change to the Saturday Vigil Mass Time

After reviewing results from the recent Parish Long-Range Planning process and in conjunction with numerous requests expressed over the years, Epiphany will be initiating a change to the Saturday Night Mass. Some parishioners feel uncomfortable about driving to Church in the dark and have asked that the Mass be celebrated at 4:30 PM. The Worship Committee has discussed the pros and cons of such a move and has decided to pilot this change during the winter months (November–February) beginning on the weekend of November 14th. We will re-evaluate after this trial period and determine if the change will become permanent. Please know that we want everyone to be safe as they come to worship.

We are grateful for her tireless work in this area of ministry under two different pastors. As Sheila moves on to other work, we wish her all the best in her future endeavors. 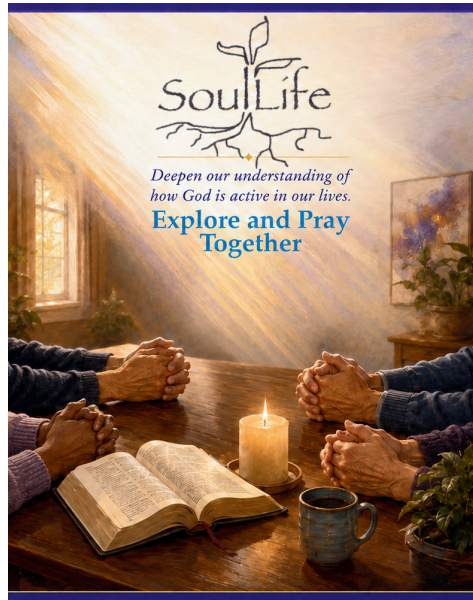

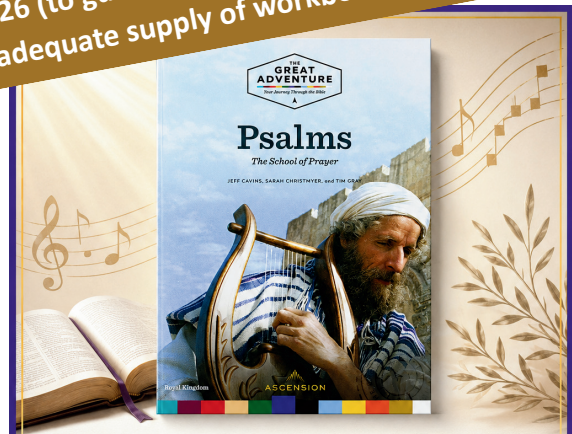
Location: The Lighthouse

Guided by Jeff Cavins, Dr. Tim Gray, & Sarah Christmyer, this eleven-session study explores how the Psalms teach us to pray and respond to God with faith and trust. At the heart of Scripture are the Psalms, prayers inspired by the Holy Spirit, sung by Israel, and prayed by Christ and our Blessed Mother. These sacred hymns invite us into a personal dialogue with God. In this study, you will explore the Psalms and discover how these ancient prayers express every human emotion while pointing to the life and mission of Jesus. It is designed to help participants meditate on Scripture, pray using Lectio Divina, and develop a deeper life of prayer.

There is no cost to register for this event. Each registration comes with a workbook.

If you are sharing a workbook with another registrant, do only ONE registration (you may put both names on a single registrant entry). Who among us has not experienced hardship when hope seems beyond our reach? Someone we love dies, we are accused unjustly, we are injured, or we lose a job. For the houseless, immigrants, the seriously ill, and the poor, hardship is part of daily life – sometimes for years.

Today's Psalm 89: 9-14 is a prayer of hope for all. "The Lord is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble. Those who know your name, trust in you; you never forsake those who seek you, Lord." The psalm invites believers to become instruments through whom God's justice and peace become visible.

How do we focus our lives on contributing to God's plan for a world of peace, justice, truth, and mercy? Pope Leo XIV has called for peacemaking, care for migrants, and solidarity and aid for those who live precariously on the margins of society.

The 2026 Season of Creation is an annual ecumenical celebration of prayer and action, Sept. 1 through Oct. 4, to protect the environment and care for the earth. It is observed globally by Christians and affirmed by Pope Leo XIV. Epiphany will open the Season at 7 p.m., Sept. 1 with an Interdenominational Prayer Service in our Worship Center. The five weeks of the Season will feature a variety of events including: a photo contest for youth, K-5, 6-8, & 9-12; a Social Concerns Forum on Sept. 10 about the status of fresh water during the rise of data centers and other negative impacts; and the archdiocesan-wide Green Mass hosted by Epiphany at 7 p.m., Sept. 30.
